CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Gleason and a quorum was recognized.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Moved by Ms. Goss to approve the agenda; seconded by Mr. Faucette. The motion received a 7-0 vote.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Moved by Ms. Goss to approve the minutes of April 12, 2018; seconded by Mr. Allen. The motion received a 7-0 vote.

ZTA-2018-02, Art. 21 Open Space

Senior Planner/Stormwater Administrator Randy Cahoon-Tingle presented proposed amendments to CDO Article 21 Open Space regarding active recreation components. Moved by Mr. Forsythe to adopt the Consistency Statement as amended to add "within open space"; seconded by Ms. Goss. The motion received a 7-0 vote.

The consistency statement reads as follows:

ZTA-2018-02, CDO Article 21- Open Space

Pursuant to NCGS§160A-383 (Consistency Statement relating to proposed changes to zoning and development regulation ordinances), and Section 4.2-3(A) and 5.3-3(B) and (D) of the Creedmoor

Development Ordinance, the City of Creedmoor Planning Board makes this recommendation regarding proposed changes to the Creedmoor Development Ordinance and/or Official Zoning Map:

We recommend **approval** of Application **ZTA-2018-02** by the City Board of Commissioners for amendment of **Article 21** of the Creedmoor Development Ordinance. Adopting these amendments will further the goal identified in City Plan 2030 of expanding recreation within open space – passive and active – to serve the needs of all residents of the City.

The Planning Board finds this proposed amendment to the Creedmoor Development Ordinance to be **consistent** with the applicable provisions of the City Plan 2030 comprehensive plan (and/or any other officially adopted plan that is applicable).

The Planning Board also provides the following comments regarding the application (optional):

On May 10, 2018, the Planning Board, by a majority vote, recommended **approval** to the City of Creedmoor Board of Commissioners of this proposed change to the Creedmoor Development Ordinance.

CREEDMOOR: CITY PLAN 2040

Community Development Director Mike Frangos reviewed Chapter 1 of City Plan 2040, to be titled *Introduction to Creedmoor*. He also reviewed highlights of the most recent statistical demographic information available from the American Community Survey. The board suggested several items to consider including from recent history.

STAFF REPORT

Mr. Frangos provided updates on the CMAQ sidewalk project, Brame's Crossing, Holly Creek, and R5707 highway alignment.
