RESOLUTION 2019-R-07:

RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE GRANVILLE COUNTY INVOLUNTARY COMMITMENT TRANSPORTATION PLAN

- Whereas,** pursuant to N.C.G.S. 112C-251(a), the County has the duty to provide, through its law enforcement officers, transportation services to support involuntary commitment proceedings of Article 5 of Chapter 122C of the North Carolina General Statutes for residents of unincorporated Granville County, or residents taken into custody within unincorporated Granville County limits; and
- Whereas,** the City has the duty to provide transportation of a respondent who is a resident of the city or who is physically taken into custody in the city limits and cities and counties may contract with each other to provide transportation; and
- Whereas,** law enforcement, local acute care hospitals, and mental health providers shall participate in developing the transportation agreement; and
- Whereas,** the agreement may designate law enforcement officers, volunteers, or other public or private personnel to provide custody and transport for individuals undergoing involuntary commitment proceedings; and
- Whereas,** the Granville County Sheriff's Office, Butner Public Safety, Creedmoor Police Department, Oxford Police Department, Stem Police Department, and Stovall Police Department have approved the Granville County Transportation Plan for Involuntary Commitments; and
- Whereas,** the Local Management Entities/Managed Care Organizations shall adopt a community crisis services plan that incorporates the transportation agreement and facilitate the first commitment examination in conjunction with a health screening for individuals under involuntary commitment

Now therefore, be it resolved that the City of Creedmoor Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes and adopts a Transportation Plan for Involuntary Commitments with the Creedmoor Police Department in conjunction with the Granville County Sheriff's Office and each of the municipalities located within Granville County with the provisions herein.

Adopted by vote of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Creedmoor this the 4th day of November, 2019, upon motion from Commissioner Anderson and second by Commissioner Wilkins.
