RESOLUTION 2020-R-03:

A RESOLUTION OF INTENT PROPOSING TO CHANGE THE MAYOR'S TERM OF OFFICE FROM TWO YEARS TO FOUR YEARS

- Whereas,** The Charter of the City of Creedmoor provides that the Mayor shall be elected for a term of two years; and
- Whereas,** N.C. Gen. Stat. § 160A-101 authorizes the Creedmoor Board of Commissioners to amend the form of government as set forth in the City Charter, including the terms of office of elected officials, by adopting an ordinance to that effect, consistent with the requirements of N.C. Gen. Stat. § 160A-102; and
- Whereas,** the Creedmoor Board of Commissioners believes that the citizens and government of the City will be better served by having the Mayor serve a term of four years; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF CREEDMOOR THE FOLLOWING:

- Section 1.** The Board of Commissioners shall hold a public hearing on March 3, 2020 to receive public comment on the question of whether to amend the City of Creedmoor Charter to give the Mayor a four-year term of office. As stated in Section 3 below, the Board shall not approve or reject the proposed Charter amendment until the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Commissioners.
- Section 2.** As required by G.S. § 160A-102, the City Clerk shall publish a notice of the public hearing in the local newspaper at least once not less than ten days prior to March 3, 2020. The notice shall contain a summary of the proposed Charter amendment.
- Section 3.** As required by G.S. § 160A-102, following the public hearing but not earlier than the next regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners and not later than 60 days from the date of the hearing, the Board of Commissioners may adopt an ordinance amending the Creedmoor Charter as described by this resolution and attached draft ordinance. Additionally, the Board of Commissioners shall consider whether to make the proposed Charter amendment subject to a vote of the people.
- Section 4.** This resolution is effective upon adoption.

Adopted by vote of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Creedmoor this the 4th day of February, 2020, upon motion from Commissioner Ed Mims.
