City Manager Mike Bonfield reported that per the Board's request, he inquired on the listing price of the depot property, which is \$290,000.

Regarding the Dudley property, Ms. Dudley agreed to the \$35,000 sale price. She would like the SGAH signage left on the property, but a sign easement for agreed upon period of time and a sign permit would be needed. The board concurred to give Mr. Bonfield approval to negotiate and present results at the next meeting.

#### Redacted - Ongoing litigation

Regarding the Harris property at 122 Pecan Street, the house needs to be torn down as a public nuisance. Attorney Jim Wrenn is going to approach county commissioners to ask if the county would put the property up for sale. If no bidders, he will inquire if the city and county could jointly rebid for the property for the cost of the taxes owed and demolish the house. Mayor Pro Tem Wilkins moved to authorize Mr. Morphis to begin work on the process of taking care of the Harris property on Pecan Street; seconded by Commissioner Anderson. The motion received a 5-0 vote.
