## RESOLUTION 2020-R-11 APPROVING CONVEYANCE OF SURPLUS PROPERTY TO A GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATION PURSUANT TO G.S. 160A-280

**WHEREAS**, the City of Creedmoor owns 12 expired bullet proof vests (PT Armor Serial #s 049269, 055278, 56203, 55983, 57716, 57717, and ABA Serial #s 12279634, 96397054, 06056206, 13127713, 06123957 and with no identifiable serial #), which are deemed to be surplus, having no value; and

**WHEREAS**, North Carolina General Statute § 160A-280 authorizes a city to donate personal property that the governing board deems to be surplus to another governmental unit pursuant to North Carolina General Statute § 160A-274(a); and

**WHEREAS**, the Vance Granville Community College, Basic Law Enforcement Training program requested the City of Creedmoor donate said expired for use in training new law enforcement officers; and

**WHEREAS**, public notice has been posted by the clerk five days prior to the adoption of this resolution;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the City of Creedmoor Board of Commissioners that:

1. The City Manager is hereby directed to donate the bullet proof vest to the Vance Granville Community College, Basic Law Enforcement Training program, and he is authorized to execute all documents necessary to complete the transfer; and
2. The vests are to be used by the Vance Granville Community College, Basic Law Enforcement Training program, a government unit, for public safety training use.
