SECTION IV: Community Center Rules

Creedmoor Community Center Rules

- An active Membership and RecCard is required for entry into the Community Center. Two (2) RecCards are provided with each membership, additional or replacement cards can be purchased for \$5/card. Attendees or guests of private events hosted at the facility shall not be required to have an active Membership and/or RecCard.
- Participants must check in with the front desk upon arrival, regardless of where they enter the facility. Unaccompanied minors between the ages of 13 and 17 are expected to check out at the front desk when they leave.
- Minors ages 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult. Minors ages 12 and under must be a member or shall pay the daily drop in fee for admission. Minors ages 12 and under may be accompanied by an adult who is a member but who is not on the same membership account as the minor.
- Minors under the age of 13 are not permitted to utilize the fitness equipment; minors 13-15 are permitted to utilize Community Center fitness equipment after completing an orientation and minor equipment use waiver. Adult members may request an equipment orientation for themselves or minors aged 13-17 on their household membership at any time.
- · Proper attire must be worn at all times, this includes a shirt and athletic shoes. Cleats are prohibited.
- Food and drinks, with the exception of bottled water, are prohibited in the gym and fitness areas, except as otherwise provided by law or required by medical necessity.
- The Creedmoor Community Center is a tobacco free campus. Tobacco use of any kind is prohibited on Creedmoor Community Center grounds and inside the facility. This includes, but is not limited to cigarettes, cigars, e-cigarettes (e.g., vaping), and smokeless tobacco.

SECTION V: CODE OF CONDUCT

Code of Conduct

NEVER TOLERATED AND REASON FOR IMMEDIATE REMOVAL AND DISMISSAL

- Foul, derogatory, or abusive language or disrespect towards a staff member, volunteer, another participant, or member of the public.
- Verbal, physical, or visual harassment of another participant, staff member, or member of the public of any kind
- Bullying or taking unfair advantage of any participant or guest.
- Possession or usage of alcoholic beverages (outside of approved rentals with security) or illegal drugs or using the Community Center while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- Possession of dangerous or unauthorized materials such as firearms, weapons, or other similar items on City property
- Conduct endangering the life, safety, health, or well-being of others.
- Abuse and/or misuse of city property or equipment is unacceptable. Misuse, moving, or altering any portion of the center property is prohibited. Violators will be held financially responsible for damages and losses.
- Failure to follow any City of Creedmoor or Parks and Recreation Department policy or procedures.

SECTION VI: WAIVER

Refunds

The Creedmoor Community Center will work hard to keep the facility open to the public as much as possible, but it may be necessary to close a portion or all of facilities for repairs and restoration. Refunds will not be given for any reason, with the exception of programs cancelled by the City due to weather emergencies, insufficient registration, or instructor cancellations.

<u>Internet</u>

The Creedmoor Community Center only provides access to the internet. The department cannot and is not able to monitor any information on the internet for content or accuracy. The user is the ultimate judge of appropriateness, in the case of minors, this responsibility rests with their parents or legal guardians. The City of Creedmoor is not responsible for any negative consequences that may occur as a result of the internet connection.

Unaccompanied Minors

Minors under the age of thirteen (13) must be accompanied by an adult or guardian (age 18 or older) in all areas of the facility at all times unless enrolled in a program that explicitly states it provides supervision. The Creedmoor Community Center does not provide direct supervision of unaccompanied minors between the ages of 13-17, with the exception of formal programming that explicitly details the level of supervision provided (e.g., Teen Center operations). Creedmoor Community Center staff requests that minors check out upon leaving the facility, however, unaccompanied minors with a valid membership and Rec Card may enter and exit the facility at their leisure.

Assumption of Risk

I hereby acknowledge that visitation of the Creedmoor Community Center and participation in associated programming activities comes with inherent risks, including, but not limited to severe illness, personal injury, permanent disability, and in some cases, death. I have full knowledge and understanding of the risks associated with participation these activities and acknowledge that the risks include but are not limited to: (1) slips, trips, and falls; (2) athletic and workout related injuries; (3) illness, including exposure to infection with viruses and bacteria.

Consent to Treat

I and/or my child(ren) are in the necessary physical condition to participate in the registered activity. I authorize the staff to seek emergency medical care on my behalf or on behalf of child if needed. I will assume all costs associated with any such treatment.

Waiver and Indemnification
