NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that a Public Hearing will be held remotely by the City of Creedmoor Board of Commissioners for consideration of the following zoning text amendment to the Creedmoor Development Ordinance.

ZTA-2021-02: Planning Staff propose changes to Creedmoor Development Ordinance Articles 2, 3, 10, 13, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 21, 22, and 23 in accordance with the reorganization and updating of State land use law per General Statute Chapter 160D – Local Planning and Development Regulation, and to comply with the Reed Supreme Court decision regarding sign regulations, and to incorporate administrative technical updates, reorganization, and correction of errors throughout these Articles.

The public hearing will be held as part of the regular agenda on **June 1, 2021**. The meeting begins at **6:00 p.m.** through the Zoom conferencing application. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and social distancing guidelines, the public will be able to attend the meeting online and via telephone only. No inperson public attendance will take place at City Hall.
