RESOLUTION 2021-R-12

A RESOLUTION EXEMPTING SURVERYING AND ENGINEERING PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF G.S. CHAPTER 143, ARTICLE 3D

Whereas, G.S. § 143-64.31(a) requires that North Carolina municipalities select firms to provide

architectural, engineering, surveying and/or construction management at risk services on the basis of demonstrated competence and qualification for the type of professional services required

without regard to fee other than unit price; and

Whereas, G.S. § 143-64.32 authorizes the City of Creedmoor Board of Commissioners to exempt in writing

any project from the requirements of G.S. Chpt. 143, Art. 3D where the estimated professional

fee is an amount less than Fifty Thousand 00/100 Dollars (\$50,000); and

Whereas, the City seeks to hire SEPI engineering to conduct surveying and engineering work relating to a

proposed expansion of the City Hall government facility. The estimated fee for this work is less than Twenty-Five thousand 00/100 Dollars (\$25,000.00) or less, and the proposed scope of work

is to prepare a site survey and conduct a phase I environmental assessment:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF CREEDMOOR:

Section 1. The surveying services described here are exempted from the requirements of G.S. Chapter 143, Article 3D.

Section 2. The Creedmoor City Manager is authorized to spend no more than Twenty-Five Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$25,000.00) for the engineering work described herein.

Section 3. All provisions of any city ordinance or resolution in conflict with this resolution are repealed.

Section 4. This resolution shall become effective upon adoption.

ADOPTED by vote of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Creedmoor this, the 1st day of June, 2021 upon motion from Commissioner Del Mims.
