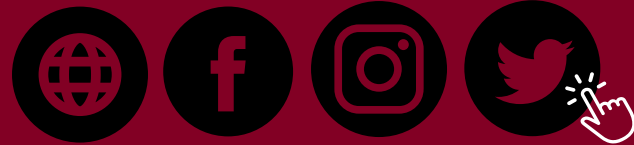

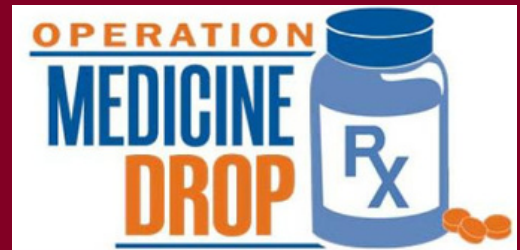
VETERANS SERVICE OFFICE
