
CREEDMOOR MUSIC FESTIVAL

In 1992, six citizens and employees created the first Creedmoor Music Festival. What began as an acoustic


Bluegrass festival has bloomed into a diverse mix of Country, Rock, Bluegrass and Alternative music.



Hawley Middle School Announcement

On April 25, 2023, the City of Creedmoor called a meeting to share their concerns about the conversion of Creedmoor Elementary to Hawley Middle School. The Granville County School Administration had sent emails stating their plans for managing the traffic flow with this change.

On behalf of the City, Commissioner Kicinski reached out to the NC-DOT, Granville County Schools, County Commissioner Russ May, Mayor Wheeler, City Manager, Creedmoor Chief of Police, Community Development Director, and City Engineer to call a meeting in the Willow Oak Room located in the Creedmoor Community Center concerning the school's plans and how it would affect our residents. At that time, the concern was gridlock that would back up Highway 56, 50, and 15, for residents and through commuters, if a traffic flow plan was not instituted. So, at that meeting, it was decided that the best way to avoid that situation was to NOT allow ANY left-hand turns IN or OUT of the entrance to the new Hawley School location. All stakeholders agreed. On Saturday, August 5th, 2023 NC-DOT installed traffic control bollards in front of the entrance. We know this may be inconvenient for some parents, but it is the only way to avoid gridlock of a much larger magnitude. County and City representatives are still working with NCDOT to make a better plan for all, but it will take some time. We are asking for your patience and cooperation through the growing pains. *Thank you*.
