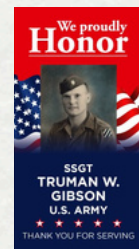

A Monument Dedication Ceremony took place on Friday afternoon June 21, 2024 for the Creedmoor Veterans Memorial with many local officials in attendance. In addition to a warm welcome and comments provided by Mayor Robert Wheeler, a heartfelt rendition of the National Anthem was performed by country music artist and Marine veteran Jason Michael Carroll. The new monument honors the memory and sacrifices of our nation's veterans who bravely serviced. The black granite monument features service medallions for the Army, Marines, Navy, Air Force, Space Force and the Coast Guard. The monument is located at the Creedmoor Community Center at 108 E. Wilton Avenue. On Monday October 2, 2023, at a regular meeting of the Creedmoor City Commissioners, North Carolina House of Representative Matthew Winslow and Representative Frank Sossamon appeared before the Board to give the City some good news and then presented a check for \$250,000 to the City for Capital Improvements to City Hall and the Police Department. Renovations are scheduled for FY-2024-2025 and will include work on the Exterior (Emergency Generator, Solar Panels, ADA enhancements, etc.), Interior (HVAC replacement, carpeting, vinyl floor tile, painting, etc) and Parking Lot (repairs and repaving) portions of the building, located at 111 Masonic Street.

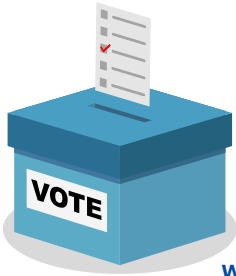
