On Monday October 2, 2023, at a regular meeting of the Creedmoor City Commissioners, North Carolina House of Representative Matthew Winslow and Representative Frank Sossamon appeared before the Board to give the City some good news and then presented a check for \$250,000 to the City for Capital Improvements to City Hall and the Police Department. Renovations are scheduled for FY-2024-2025 and will include work on the Exterior (Emergency Generator, Solar Panels, ADA enhancements, etc.), Interior (HVAC replacement, carpeting, vinyl floor tile, painting, etc) and Parking Lot (repairs and repaving) portions of the building, located at 111 Masonic Street.
