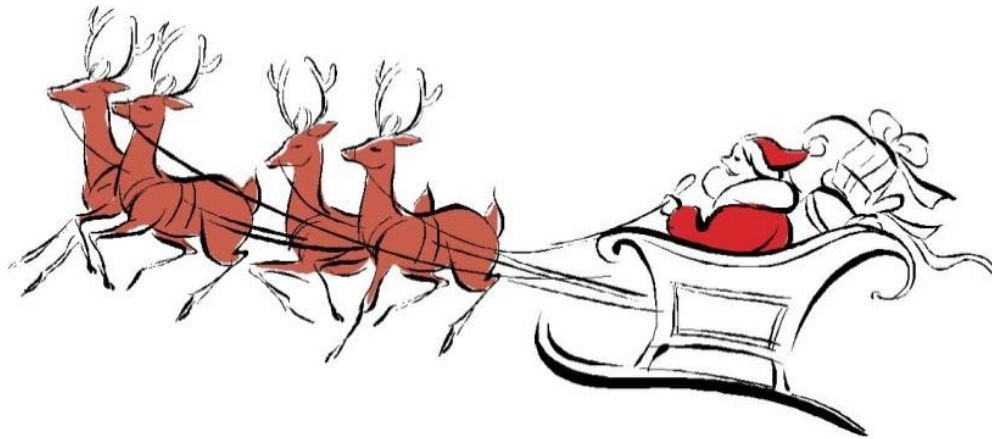


# *2024 City of Creedmoor Christmas Parade Application*

Applications must be received by Friday, November 22, 2024. All donations benefit the 2024 Creedmoor Police Department's Shop with a Cop Program.

## **Accepted Entrants:**

Accepted participants will be notified via email by Friday, November 29, 2024, with parade lineup details and other pertinent information.

**Instructions for Participants: Date:** Saturday, December 7, 2024 at 11:00 AM

## **Required Sign-In:**

- **When:** Registration starts at 9:30 AM and closes promptly at 10:30 AM.
- **Where:** Check-in at the intersection of Main Street and East Church Street. One representative per group must sign in. All vehicles must be in the staging area by 10:30 AM, and a driver must remain with each vehicle at all times.

## **Line-Up:**

- **When:** All participants must be on-site, checked in, and lined up by 10:30 AM.
- **Where:** Line-up begins at the intersection of Main Street and East Church Street. Assigned positions will be communicated via email and posted online a few days before the parade. Group entries should use the South Granville High School parking lot for loading. The business parking lot at Church and Main Streets is reserved for marching bands and professional floats, and will be staffed.

## **Parade Route:**

- The parade starts at Main Street and East Church Street and ends at Main Street (PNC Bank) and Lake Road. Please do not unload at Creedmoor Community Center; continue to South Granville High School parking lot for unloading.

## **Parade Rules:**

- Please communicate these rules to all participants:
  - Festive attire is strongly encouraged.
  - Only one Santa Claus is permitted in the parade.
  - All hands and feet must remain inside vehicles and floats; participants must remain seated.
  - Floats must stop completely before participants disembark.
  - Do not leave the parade until reaching Main Street and Hwy 56 (CVS); continue to South Granville High School for unloading.
  - Adult supervision is required for all children under 14.
  - Only adults should throw candy to increase safety.
  - Loud noises such as car motors and motorcycle revving are discouraged.
  - Participants must keep moving forward and refrain from stopping to perform.
  - Clubs and organizations are limited to 3 walking groups or 2 vehicles per application, fitting within a 40'x6' space.
  - Motorcyclists must wear proper DOT-approved helmets.
  - Teams, troops, and tribes should wear uniforms or matching attire with identifiable signs or banners.
  - The parade is rain or shine.
  - No selling items along the parade route.
